Rules:

- Open to any individual who is a Virginia resident. Participants may compete at fairs outside their area, depending on the residency requirements of that specific fair. Local fairs are asked to waive any residency requirements, if possible, but understand if you cannot. Participants are eligible to place in ONE contest only - contestants may not compete in another fair once they have placed first, second or third at any fair.
- Entrant must prepare any type of their Mom's recipe that contains a **minimum of 4 large eggs**.
- Entry should be presented on/in a container for judging that can be left for display should the item win.
- Recipe must list ingredients in order of use; preparation instructions; pan size (and type); number of servings; cooking time; and temperatures. Recipes must be on one side of page and must be submitted with prepared entry. Back side of page must include contestant's name, address, phone and email address and the name of the item. Typewritten will look the most professional but is not essential.

Notes:

- Your fair accepts any liability if entries are served to the public (*our suggestion is not to serve*).
- Fairs are in charge of safe food handling procedures (accept items that should be kept cold from coolers, and judge hot items promptly or keep cold and reheat samples to appropriate tasting temperature).
- A sample judging form is available, but *modifications may be made to suit your fair*.
- Fairs will determine whether or not to share judges' forms with participants.
- This is an adult competition - Contestants under age 18 may compete but will be judged as adults.
- Recipes will become the property of the Virginia Egg Council and may be altered.

Winners' Information and recipes must be submitted to the VA Egg Council - at this point, prizes for local winners and 'finals' competition information will be sent to them. *All competing recipes may be sent as well.*

Judging should be based on:

Recipe requirements filled, Flavor, Appearance, Appropriateness of Ingredients for Recipe, Creativity, Texture
